Fall has arrived, and with it begins the new Sunday School year! We kicked off our first day on September 14th with a welcome breakfast for our families. Eight students in grades PreK – 6 attended that first day: PreK-K (3), Grade 2 (1), Grade 3 (1), Grade 4 (1), and Grade 6 (2). We expect a total of 11 to officially register for 2025-26.

We are continuing with our children's ministry series, "The Bible in One Year," part of Group's "Dig In" curriculum. Through this series, kids discover that they're

a lot like people we read about in the Bible that God has always loved and worked through. Because we do not meet all year long and occasionally break for special lessons, we did not finish this series last year, when we began in Genesis. Our first lesson for this year was found in Judges 6-7, the story of how God sent Gideon to rescue the Israelites from the Midianites. We learned that God sees the best in us (the first of our weekly Bible points), even if we don't think we have what it takes to carry out his plans. Our summary verse was Joshua 1:9, "This is my command—be strong and courageous! Do not be afraid or discouraged. For the Lord your God is with you wherever you go." We expect to complete this series by the end of the Sunday School year.

At this time, we are continuing to meet the entire hour in one large group, applying VBS style lesson reinforcement activities that speak to all ages. Due to the number of younger students this year, our hope is to break into two groups for part of the hour (approximately 15 minutes) to reinforce the lesson in an age-appropriate format (PreK-K and Grades 1-6). This will depend on available staff each week.

Special events will be incorporated throughout the year. Children are always encouraged to bring friends to Sunday School – please don't hesitate to bring visitors! We are grateful to parents and guardians of our students for bringing their children each week and to our staff for their service. So far, staff for the year are as follows:

<u>We also invite donations of prepackaged snack items and mini-water bottles.</u> Any help you can give is greatly appreciated.



As we near the holiday season, we will again be inviting the congregation to participate with us in "Operation Christmas Child, the shoebox gift donation drive sponsored by Samaritan's Purse; you'll hear more about that in the coming month. Please be aware that there will be <u>no Sunday School on October 19th</u>. This is a long weekend for students (MEA) and families often take the opportunity to travel during this time.
